MODULE 1: WHAT AFFILIATE MARKETING REALLY IS

At its core, affiliate marketing works when:

Affiliate marketing is a business activity, even at the very beginning.

That means:

Tracking income

Tracking expenses

Keeping simple records

You do not need:

An accountant on day one

Complex software

Legal jargon

You do need:

Honesty

Consistency

A basic system

Treating affiliate marketing casually is one of the biggest reasons beginners fail.

MODULE 3: CHOOSING A NICHE (WITHOUT OVERTHINKING)

A niche simply means:

Who you help, and what you help them with.

Good beginner niches are:

Topics you already understand

Problems you've personally solved

Everyday needs and interests

Avoid:

"Make money online" as a niche

Chasing trends you don't understand

Promoting things you wouldn't use

Clarity is more important than popularity.

MODULE 4: FINDING LEGITIMATE AFFILIATE PRODUCTS

Not all affiliate programmes are legitimate.

Before promoting anything, you should be able to answer:

Is this a real product or service?

Would I buy it myself?

Is the company transparent?

Are commissions clearly explained?

If a programme focuses more on recruiting affiliates than serving customers, it should be avoided.

MODULE 5: TIKTOK FOR AFFILIATE BEGINNERS

TikTok is a traffic platform — not a business.

It can help you:

Reach people

Educate

Build awareness

It cannot:

Replace a website

Protect your business long-term

Guarantee income

Used correctly, TikTok supports affiliate marketing by building trust through helpful content.

Used incorrectly, it leads to account bans, lost links, and broken businesses.

This guide shows you how to use TikTok safely and ethically.

MODULE 6: THE SAFE AFFILIATE FLOW

A proper affiliate setup follows this flow:

TikTok

→ Link-in-bio page

→ Your website or landing page

→ Affiliate product

This structure:

Protects your account

Builds trust

Keeps you compliant

Gives you control

Direct linking and shortcuts often cause problems later.

MODULE 7: CONTENT BEFORE LINKS

Content should always come before recommendations.

That means:

Explaining

Teaching

Reviewing

Sharing experience

Affiliate links should be:

Clearly disclosed

Optional

Placed within helpful content

Pressure selling damages trust and rarely works long-term.

MODULE 8: SIMPLE INCOME & EXPENSE TRACKING

You only need to track two things:

Income received

Expenses paid

Track income when you receive it, not when a click happens.

Keep records from day one, even if the amounts are small.

Real growth is slow and steady.
