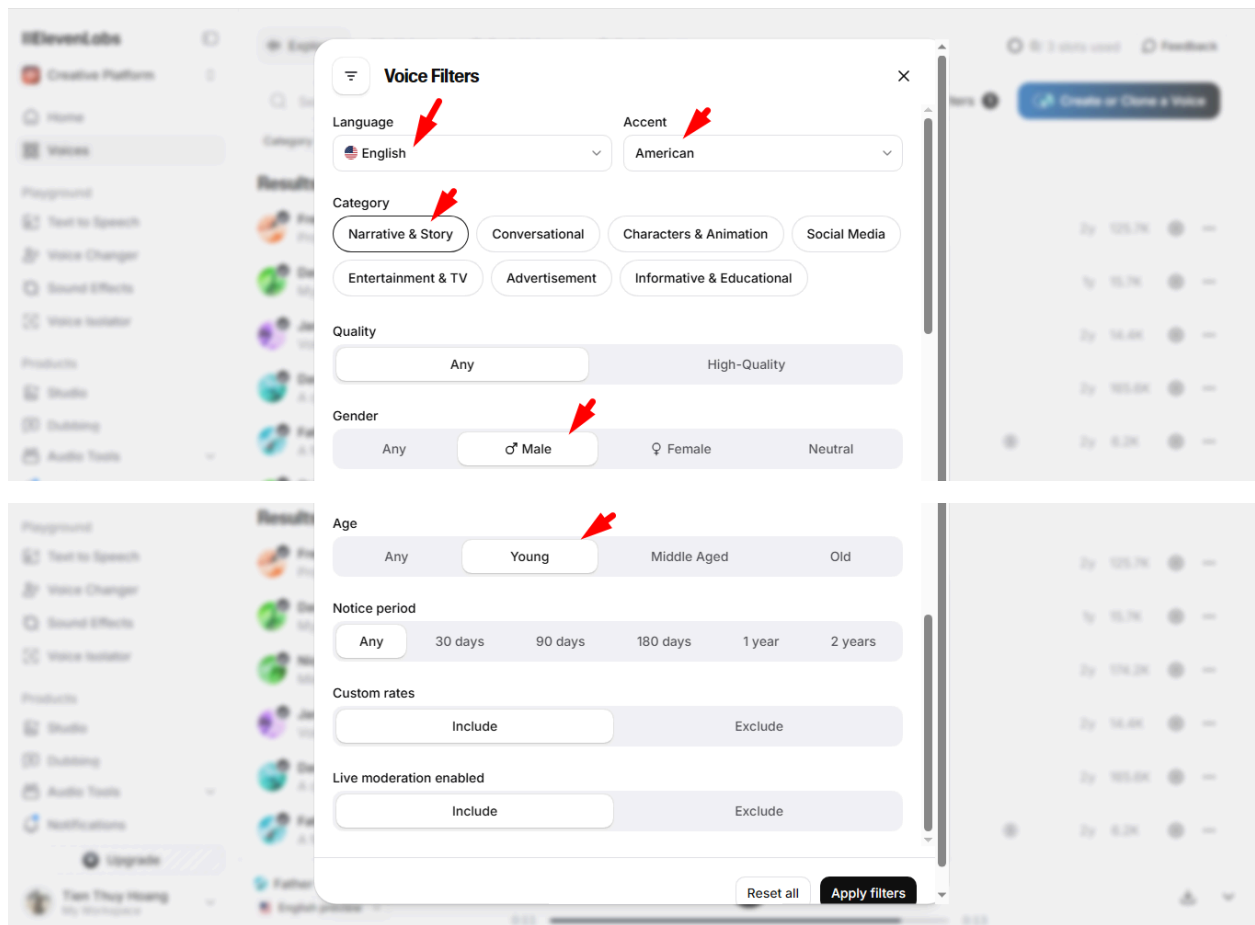

After that, you can follow these steps:

- Paste each 700–800 word block into ElevenLabs
- Choose the saved voice that you selected before
- Export the audio files section by section

This helps keep the flow natural and avoids errors that sometimes occur with long-form input.

Step 4: Create Visuals (AI + Stock Footage)

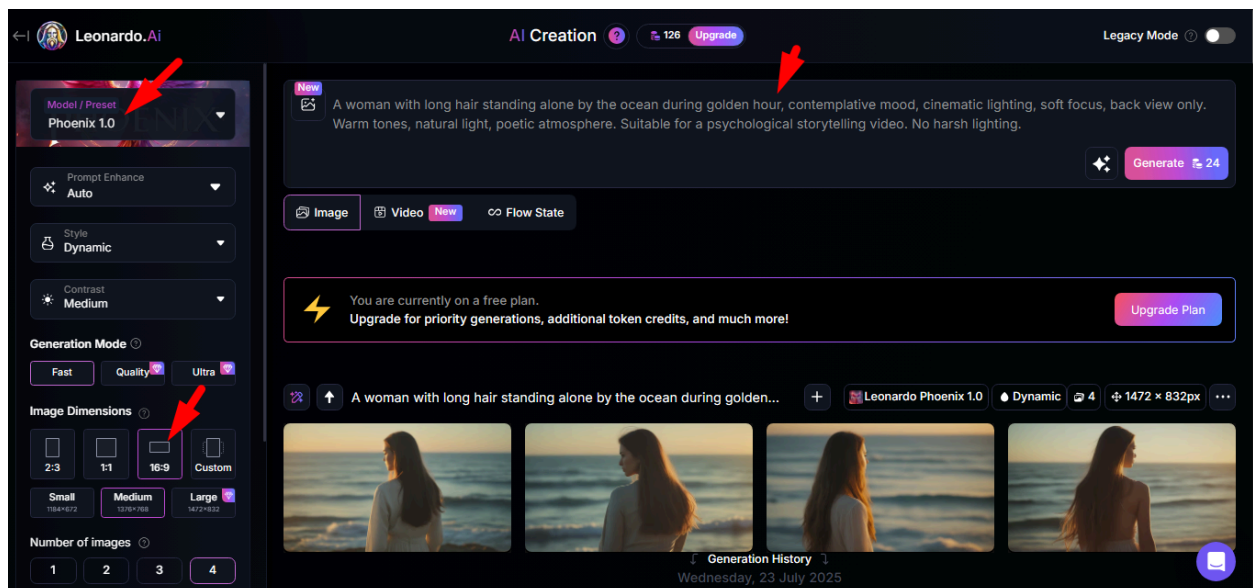
To keep your content visually engaging, combine **AI-generated images** with **free-to-use video clips**.

- Use [Leonardo.AI](#) to generate cinematic-style images that match the emotional tone of your script
- Visit free stock sites like **Pexels** or **Pixabay**, and search for terms like “forest”, “sunset”, “waves”, “introspective woman”, etc. - nature visuals often perform well for relaxing or reflective topics.

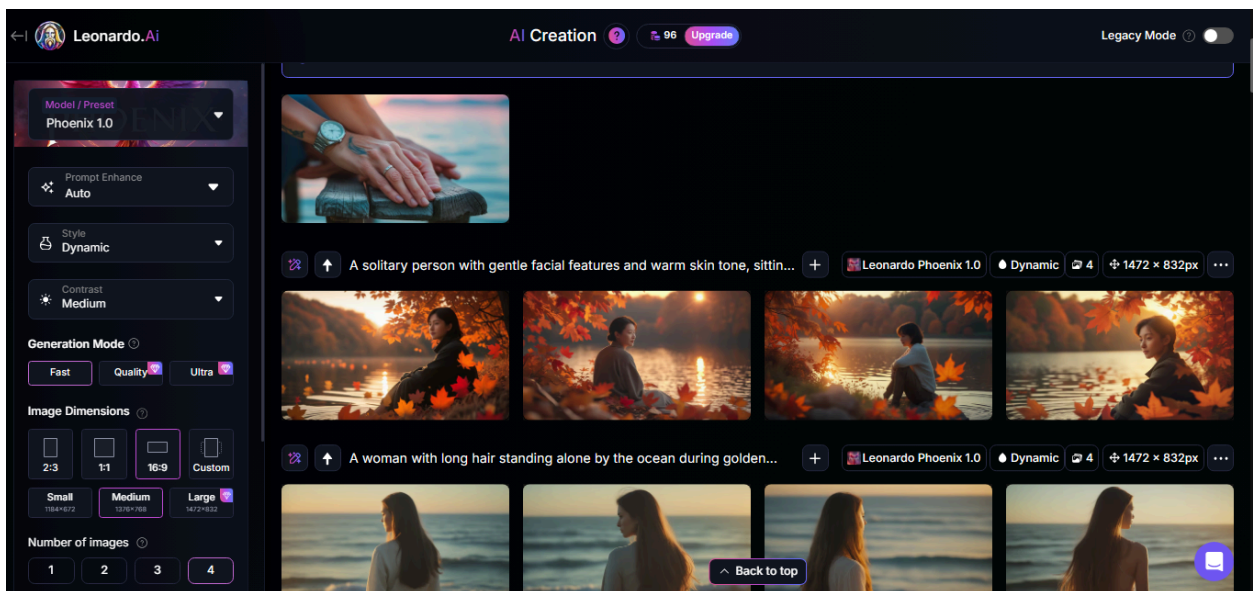

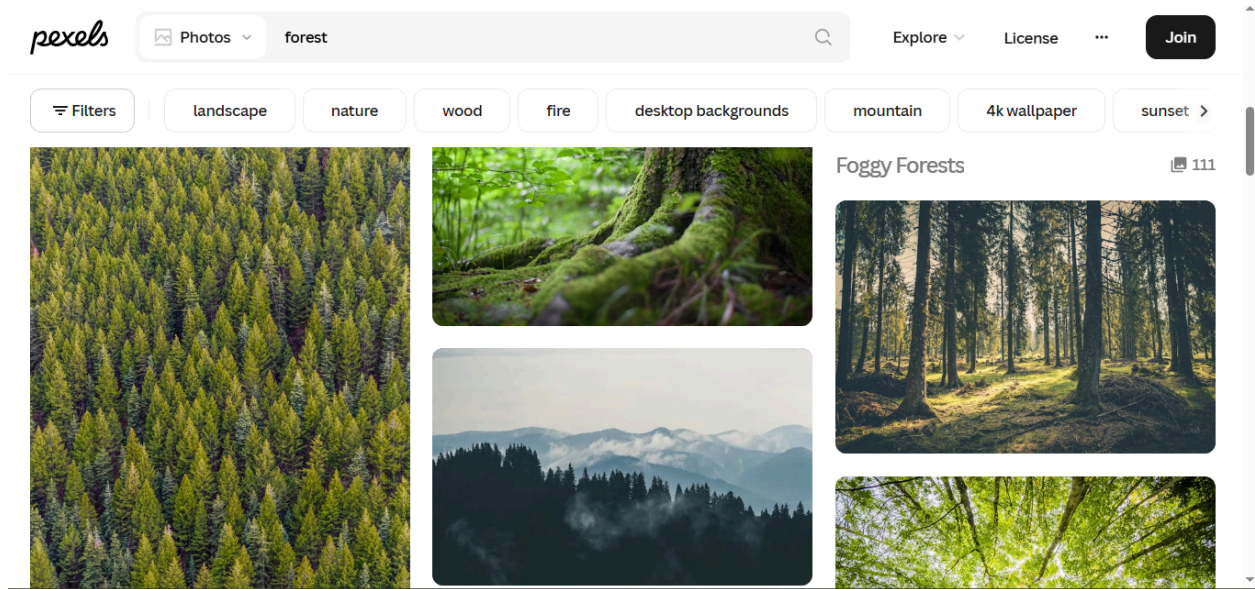

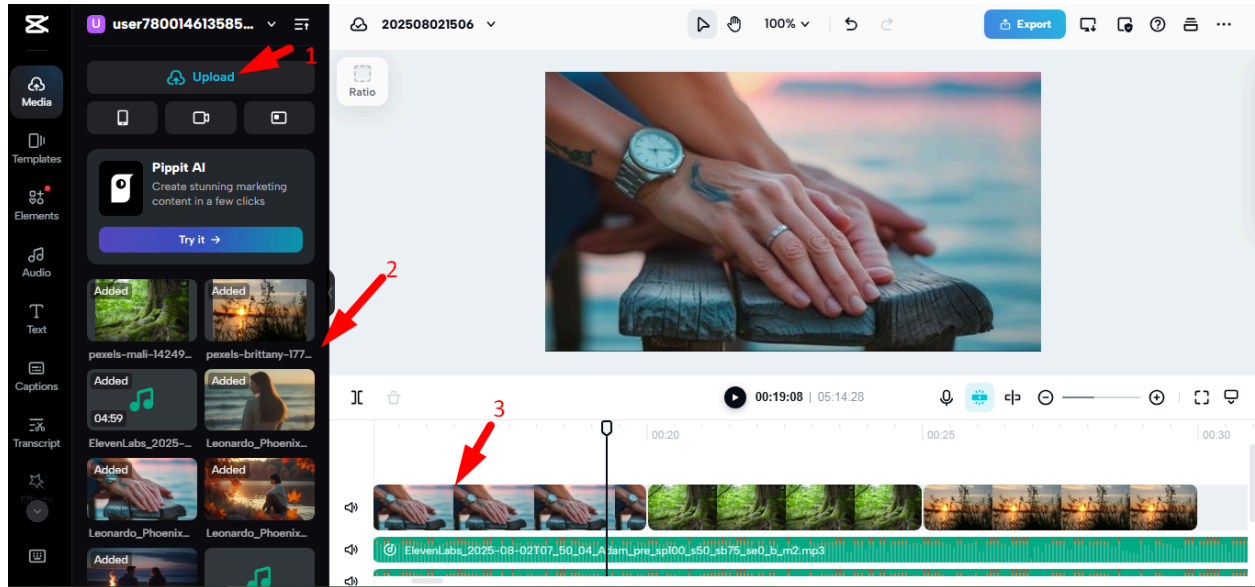
All of these prompts:

- Work perfectly with **emotional narration** scripts

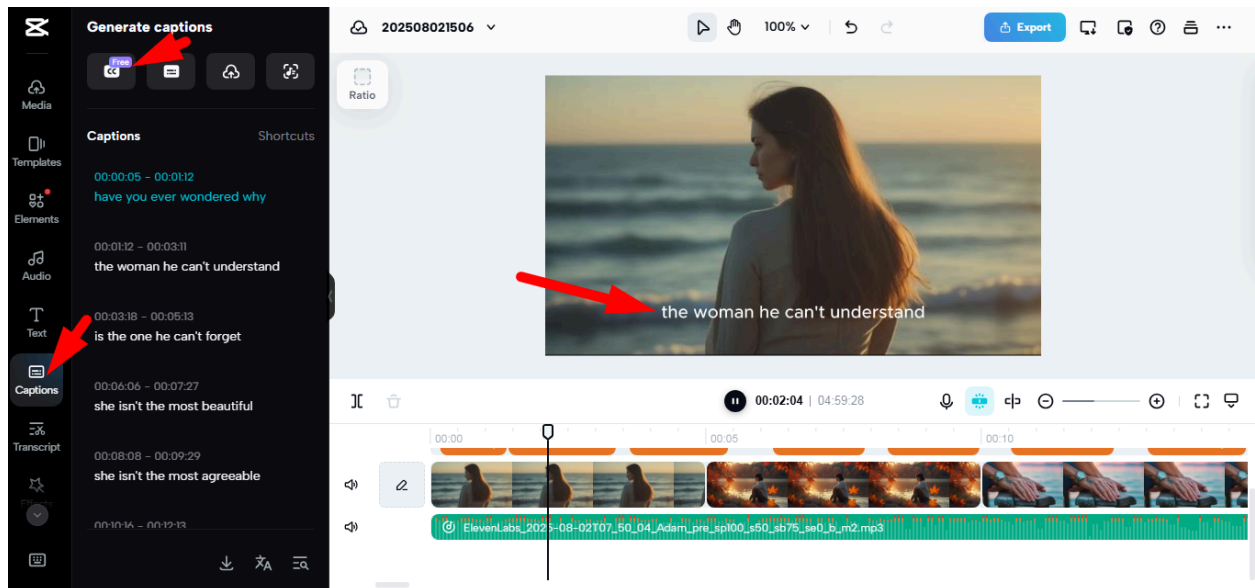
Step 5: Edit Your Video Together

Once you have the voiceovers and visuals:

1. Use a simple editor like **CapCut, DaVinci Resolve**,... I will use CapCut for this example
2. Import each voiceover file
3. Overlay images and video clips in sync with the narration:



4. Add subtitles for better retention and reach. You can custom more the subtitle text font and style for more eye-catching with CapCut:



5. Keep transitions smooth and minimal

If you'd like to, you can always test-edit a 30-second clip first to find the right pacing before building the full video.

Tip: Consistency Builds Trust

This method works - but only if you stay consistent.

Stick to a niche, develop your unique tone, and aim for regular uploads. YouTube rewards content that keeps people watching and coming back.

Final Thoughts

With just a few AI tools and a refined script prompt, you can build a high-impact channel that touches deep emotional themes - without showing your face or hiring a team.

The key isn't how fancy your tools are. It's how well you understand the audience you're speaking to - and how consistently you show up with content that resonates.
